- <u>Price List</u> Pricing is based on the current Magnuson Group Commercial Price List in effect at the time of the order.
- Freight Terms F.O.B. Woodridge, IL 60517
- <u>Payment Terms</u> Standard payment terms are net 30 days after date of invoice; we accept Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover cards for payment
- <u>Installation Fees</u> Fees for delivery and/or installation by furniture dealers are not included and will be quoted separately by the servicing dealer, as applicable.
- <u>Warranty</u> All products and parts are warranted against defects in material and workmanship for the period of two years after shipment. Warranty is void if product is damaged through accident, improper use, abuse or alteration.
- <u>Limitation of Liability</u> Magnuson Group's liability for any and all losses and damages to buyer resulting from any cause shall be limited only to the replacement or the repair of the product.
- <u>Return Policy</u> Orders in any stage of processing and production may not be cancelled without authorization in writing from Magnuson Group and may be subject to a 50% cancellation fee. If a return is authorized, a minimum restocking charge of 30% will be incurred, return freight pre-paid. Returned goods must be unused and packaged in original cartons within 90 days of original shipping date. Custom orders cannot be returned. Credit will be issued subject to inspection by our receiving department.
- <u>Non-Stock Orders</u> All orders for items that are not in stock may require a 50% nonrefundable deposit at time of order placement. In such cases, the order will not be processed until the deposit is received.
- <u>Shipping Damage/Shortage Claims</u> All shipments should be inspected carefully on delivery and any apparent damage or shortages noted as exceptions on all copies of the delivery receipt. Notification of shortages or concealed damage must be made to the delivering carrier within 3 days of receipt. Claims of either visible or concealed damage should be presented without delay to the carrier by the consignee.
- <u>Shortage Claims</u> Shortage claims reported 30 days beyond shipment date will not be honored
- <u>Design Changes</u> Magnuson Group reserves the right to improve product design, construction and quality without notice.
